Experience of Japanese culture – Kimono dressing and tea ceremony

- 11:45 We pick you up at the Arc Hotel Sendai and take you to the Sendai International Center. (This program does not include lunch. Please take lunch by yourself beforehand.)
- 12:00-13:30 You dress kimono (Japanese traditional clothes) with the help of dresser staff. Ladies wear colorful silk kimono (Japanese formal dress), and gentlemen wear “yukata”, informal cotton kimono. Dressing takes about one hour for ladies. Let us take photos after you are dressed.



- 13:30-15:00 You take a short lesson for the tea ceremony and perform it (prepare, serve and drink powdered green tea in the traditional manner) in a Japanese room with your kimono on.



- 15:00-15:30 You take off your kimono and go back to the hotel.

The partner of the accompanying person (namely, the HYP2015 attendant) is welcome free of charge. He or she can join and leave anytime (for example, he or she may join only in the lunch break of the conference).
